




### DAY 1: AVIGNON (EMBARK)




### DAY 2: TARASCON (ARLES)

### DAY 5: TOURNON (TAIN-L'HERMITAGE)








### DAY 7: MÂCON (BEAUNE)









## **S.S. CATHERINE DECK PLAN**
